Grants Awarded in Q2 2017

Chesterton High School – Music Truck, \$2,000

A project championed by Tom Schnabel, the music truck will be used to transport musical instruments and equipment to CHS Show Choir and CHS Marching Band competitions. The truck will also be used to transport equipment when the CMS orchestra visits the Duneland elementary schools.

Chesterton Middle School – Student Tech Team, \$1,645

With 50% matching funds from the CMS PTO, the grant funds will be used to purchase ten iPads with silicone covers for use by the CMS Student Tech Team, which will support learning and community engagement with a newly approved course for the 2017-18 year. The students will use the equipment daily as they work to support the CMS building, staff, and student body. The course will simulate a work environment and help students develop work skills.

Westchester Intermediate School -- MakerSpace, \$5,000

Westchester Intermediate School science teachers will advance the opportunities for STEM/STEAM/STREAM learning with a space for hands-on learning and encourage students to pursue science-related careers. The MakerSpace will allow students to create/engineer products, use the scientific method for experiments, share creations and learning through class presentations, and learn from their peers. The MakerSpace will provide teachers with a suitable space for extended projects, storage for science materials and student work, and offer a space for students to display their creations.
